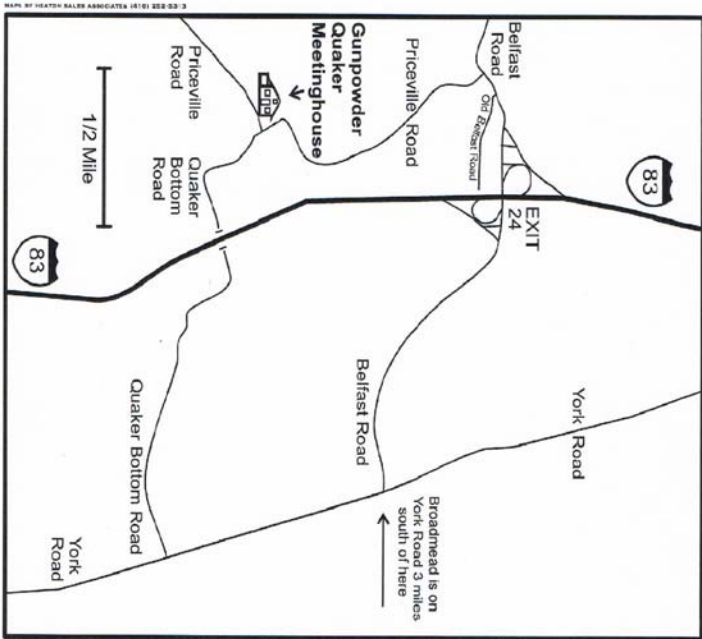

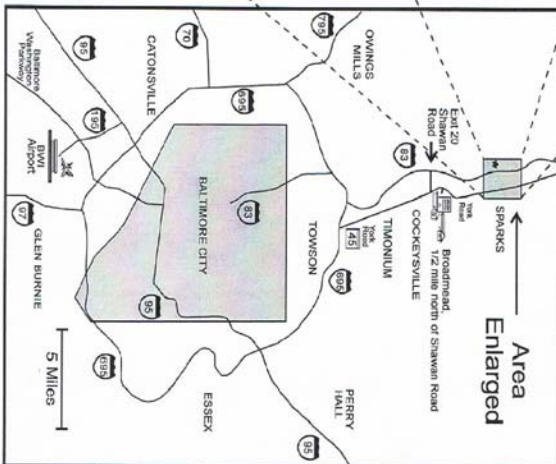
ENLARGEMENT OF A PORTION OF SPARKS, MD

Right Sharing of World Resources - RSWR

From its beginning in 1967 the basic idea of RSWR has been wealth redistribution. In 1967 we called it "right sharing". Today, we also understand it as Jubilee justice or Sabbath economics.

"Giving it back" is wealth redistribution. RSWR's distinguishing feature is in the practice of redistribution as a grant (gift) of capital, which is then owned and used by women's self-help groups to support the implementation of small-scale, income-generating businesses. Each individual recipient within a group receiving the grant (gift) must repay her loan, with interest, so that the original gift will continue to flow and grow within the communities. Come and learn more about this wonderful and exciting program.....
