Meeting for Worship suspended at FMW for 3/15 and 3/22

Beloved Friends,

Yesterday afternoon, Mayor Bowser declared a state of emergency for DC due to the public healthmeasures needed to control the spread of COVID-19. We have been following theCDC's guidelines for preparedness for faith communities as well as consulting the Friends in the medical profession. Based on the information they've beenproviding us, your co-clerks are in unity that we need to take proactive stepsto protect our community and our neighbors by not holding ourregularly-scheduled in-person spiritual gatherings on First Day, for the nexttwo weeks (3/15 and 3/22). We will also be posting a notice to our website to informisitors. The small meetings for worship on Sunday evening and Tuesdayevening will continue as scheduled.

This isn't a decisionthat we take lightly, because we know how important it is to hold oursacred space and our community in the Light on a regular basis. However, we'vecome to a moment when our Stewardship testimony is in tension with ourCommunity testimony. All of the recommendations we've been hearing have beenthat we all need to voluntarily take significant steps to limit our exposureand slow the spread of the disease to ensure that it plays out in a way thatour health institutions can comfortably manage. Please note: We know of nocases of anyone with a confirmed COVID-19 diagnosis attending the Meeting, anddon't think we are in any immediate risk. But we do believe the responsiblething to do for our neighbors and our city is to shut down all of the largerMeetings for Worship in our Meetinghouse. We also trust in our Community andbelieve we can be resilient and clever.

We're reaching out toour community of clerks to find creative ways to ensure that we can continue toconnect in the Spirit for the next two weeks. During this time, we'll bemonitoring the recommendations and working together to provide clear guidanceto our community. We will let you know when we make a decision aboutreopening our physical gatherings as soon as we can within the next twoweeks.

We have a plan inmotion to hold a virtual Meeting forWorship using our tool for videoconferences, Zoom. Some of you will befamiliar with it from our committee meetings. We also have Friends whohave volunteered to stand by and help Friends who might be having technological difficulties, as we try out this new virtual arrangement. The details forattending this online meeting have been sent in a separate email. We are also starting aseries of small Google listservsthat will connect you all, neighborhood by neighborhood. It is our hope thatyou will creatively use this tool to lean into your community in the days aheadand be a help to each other.

We want to thank allof our committee members for the tremendous leadership, empathy, care, andeffort they've shown over the past week in determining the nature of thischallenge. And we will be relying heavily on all of your wisdom and knowledgeto work through the ramifications of this virus together.
