1992	Meeting moves to Takoma Park Elementary School
2/27/1994	Meeting begins practice of reading, responding to, and recording responses to queries at meeting for business
4/25/1998	Meeting lays down the committee to nominate the nominating committee with the responsibility for its functions "transferred to the preparative meeting as a whole."
1998	Meeting moves to Takoma Park Presbyterian Church, meeting in the afternoon in the sanctuary
1999	Meeting gets a telephone line
9/26/1999	Meeting has a table at the Takoma Park Folk Festival; in later years it has tables at the city's
	street and jazz festivals
2001	Meeting moves to second floor and attic of One Columbia Avenue (then home of Crossings); it
	subsequently sets up a parallel "accessible meeting" at 7406 Jackson Avenue; attendance reaches its peak with more than thirty adults a week and six children
2003	Meeting has an eleven-month budget year so that subsequent twelve-month budget years run
	from 12/1 through 11/30; Adelphi subsequently adopts this budget year change
2004	Meeting moves to wheelchair-accessible 7014 Westmoreland Avenue (then home of Sangha)
2008	Meeting moves away from Takoma Park to Friends Community School in College Park, Maryland
2008	Meeting returns to Takoma Park, meeting at the Dance Exchange; attendance declines to five to
2016	ten people a week during the residency there Meeting prepares an "Actions to Address Climate Change" document
2010 9/1/2019	Meeting returns to Takoma Park Presbyterian Church, this time meeting in its library
3/30/2020	With Maryland state pandemic stay-at-home order, indoor meetings are suspended
4/5/2020	Online meetings for worship begin
7/5/2020	Indoor meetings resume at 11:30 a.m., with other meeting events online at 1:30 a.m.
2/21/2021	Meeting led to loan \$50,000 from its meeting place fund to Adelphi for use in Adelphi's
2/21/2021	renovation
8/26/2021	First weekly (7:30 p.m. Fifth Days) mid-week online meeting for worship
8/29/2021	Meeting returns to indoor First Day events (except for online shared meals)
10/27/2021	First weekly (3:00 p.m. Fifth Days) mid-week outdoor meeting for worship on back porch of Thomas-Siegler Carriage House
12/5/2021	Online meetings for worship shift to 7:30 p.m. on First Days
5/18/2022	Outdoor mid-week meetings for worship shift to 6:30 p.m. on Fifth Days
