



Organizational Grant Announcement

The Miles White Beneficial Society of Baltimore City (MWBS) is now accepting applications from non-profit organizations for grants of up to \$10,000. The MWBS is a 501(c)(3) organization affiliated with the Baltimore Yearly Meeting of the Religious Society of Friends (Quakers).

Preference for 2026 organizational grants will be given to organizations that promote social justice in the city of Baltimore. For purposes of this application, an organization promotes social justice if it increases equity and opportunity for all people.

The MWBS is offering three types of organizational grants for 2026:

- 1) **Health and Human Services Grants:** projects or programs designed to meet the basic human needs of the residents of Baltimore City.
- 2) **Education and Enrichment Grants:** projects or programs that provide educational or enrichment programs to young people in Baltimore City.
- 3) **Innovation Grants:** These grants are for projects or programs in Baltimore City that create new approaches (e.g., a collaboration between programs or projects) to address social justice issues.

Please clearly indicate on your application which type of grant your organization is seeking.
